Newbury & Crookham Golf Club – Covid-19 Housekeeping Rules for the Clubhouse

Please see below a summary and reminder of the key rules we all need to follow for our safety, the safety of others and to ensure our compliance with the latest Government guidance and legislation.

1. Hands

Wash your hands for a minimum of 20 seconds and use hand sanitiser before coming into the clubhouse. Avoid unnecessary contact with any objects.

2. Face

Wear a good fitting face mask when entering the clubhouse and only remove it when seated. Please note, face masks are more effective than other face coverings such as scarfs and snoods.

3. Space

Practice social distancing at all times (2 metres where possible) from people you do not live with. You must remain seated at your table and are not permitted to walk around and socialise with others.

4. Track & Trace and Temperature Check

If you have downloaded the NHS Covid-19 app, please use the 'Venue check-in' option by scanning our QR code when entering the clubhouse (and Pro shop). Alternatively, please give a member of the house team your name (and contact details if you are a visitor).

If you live in a non-Tier 1 area please do not come into the clubhouse bars or dining room. For visitors, if your clubhouse is closed due to a Covid-19 outbreak, please do not come to our club during this time.

Please also check your temperature with the digital thermometer inside the foyer. Put your forehead 2-3 inches in front of the sensor and you will hopefully hear the message 'Normal Temperature'. If your temperature reading is too high please step outside and if you wish to return in 10 minutes to recheck your temperature please do so but if the reading is still too high please attract the attention of a member of staff and leave the club.

5. TableDrop and floor plan

Use the TableDrop app to order your food and drinks. Sorry but no cash transactions can be accepted.

The table and chair floor plan has been carefully thought through. Please do not move any furniture.

6. Navigation and Signage

Follow the arrows, one-way systems, various signs in and around the clubhouse and respect the restricted areas. Please note that the showers in the changing rooms are not in use.

7. Ventilation and Heating

We are working hard to find the optimum balance between having an adequate level of airflow and a comfortable temperature. Only the house team can adjust the opening / closing of doors and windows.

Each person has a duty of care to themselves and to one another so your cooperation is much appreciated in our efforts to keep our clubhouse open.
