

Appendix 9 to the Bye Laws 2022

FOG POLICY

WHEN PLAY BEGINS FOLLOWING A FOGGY START TO THE DAY THE MAXIMUM DELAY WILL BE 30 MINUTES. ANY TEE TIME THAT IS MORE THAN 30 MINUTES PAST WILL BE DEEMED TO BE LOST FOR THE DAY.

FOR EXAMPLE, IF GOLF RESTARTS AT 10AM, THE FIRST GROUP TO TEE OFF WILL BE THE GROUP ORIGINALLY BOOKED AT 9.30AM. PLAYERS WILL THEN FOLLOW IN THE ORDER OF THE ORIGINAL TEE SHEET.

AS A GENERAL RULE WHEN CONDITIONS ARE FOGGY PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW.

IN FOGGY CONDITIONS, GOLFERS MUST NOT PLAY IF THEY CANNOT SEE WHERE THEIR SHOTS WILL FINISH, IRRESPECTIVE OF WHETHER OR NOT THE COURSE IS CLOSED

THE COURSE WILL BE CLOSED IF IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO SEE 250 YARDS FROM THE 1ST TEE.

GOLFERS MUST NOT COMMENCE THEIR ROUND IF THIS IS THE CASE.

SHOULD GOLFERS BE ALREADY ON THE COURSE WHEN THE FOG DESCENDS, THEY SHOULD PAUSE PLAY AND WAIT UNTIL IT IS SAFE TO DO SO BEFORE CONTINUING.
